1. **POST EXCHANGE:** The Post Exchange, this Station, will be closed for inventory on Friday, 31 March 1944.
2. **SQUADRON DIARY:** In accordance with 2nd Bomb Division Instructions 20-4, dated 19 January 1944, each Squadron of the 497th Bomb Group will maintain a Diary, available for inspection, and to be submitted to the Division Historical Section every two months. Details as to the type of Diary to maintain may be obtained from Lt. Goodyear at the Group S & C Office, phone 99.
3. **RESTRICTION:** Effective immediately, the Medical Restriction to limits of this Post is hereby lifted. However, any numbers of personnel in excess of ten, going together to any particular place, will have the senior in charge, and that person will be responsible for keeping his men segregated from other personnel at destination.  
This order does not lift the restriction imposed per Para. two, "Passes and Furloughs", Group Bulletin 558, this Headquarters, dated 14 Mar 44.
4. **A-2 JACKETS:** A-2 jackets will not be worn after 1700 hours unless going to, or returning from the flight line, or other place of work.
5. **BICYCLE STANDS:** Adequate numbers of bicycle stands having been provided, it is mandatory that they be used. Where bicycles are found parked in other than proper receptacles, the Provost Marshal will have the Military Police confiscate same. This is to obviate any possible casualty from the carelessness of those who, in blackout, with utter lack of common sense, leave their cycles on the walks, or in other places solely for the use of pedestrians.
