- 1. RECREATION GROUNDS: Baseball, Volley Ball or other athletic games will be played only on duly authorized sites. All land immediately outside the boundaries of the living, communal or technical sites is Private Property and will be considered as out of bounds to all personnel. The only authorized place for athletic activities is the Athletic Grounds between sites two and three.
2. HUNTING: The Rackheath Estate is private property and the sporting rights over the Park, Arable and Woods are strictly preserved so that Personnel of this station must confine themselves to the land requisitioned by the War Department and the Air Ministry - and the roads - except in case of hostile action. Shooting of firearms is prohibited in all areas unless official permissions has been granted. Domestic or wild animals will not be harmed in any manner regardless of the area in which they may be found.
3. FIREWOOD: The promiscuous collection of wood is strictly forbidden. Wood may be procured for heating purposes as follows: Unit C.O.'s or authorized representative will contact Mr. Harold H. Newman, Land Agent for Rackheath Park, who will stipulate exactly where and what wood is available. Wood will be collected by an authorized fatigue detail under the supervision of a non-com in charge.
4. PAY VOUCHERS: All Base Officers who have completed data sheets, but have not signed Pay Voucher will report to the Officers' Personnel Section immediately.
5. SPEED LIMITS: The following speed limits are in force and will be adhered to:
During Daylight
On Station (Single lane roads) - 10 M.P.H.
On Station (Double Lane roads) - 15 M.P.H.
During Darkness
On Station (All roads) - 10 M.P.H.
