1. Par 1 of 2d Bomb Division Instructions #35-13, "Letters of Condolence", dated 1 June 1944, is quoted for the information and compliance of all concerned:

Except for letters of condolence, as authorized in paragraph 12a, Circular 46, Hq. BTOUSA, 23 April 1944, no casualty information of any kind will be included in any correspondence written to relatives and friends by personnel subject to military law.

2. FRATERNIZATION: Fraternization between officers and enlisted members of the WAAF, WTS, WSES, etc., is not permitted. Par 34, Field Manual 21-50, Military Courtesy and Discipline, is considered to apply between male officers and enlisted women and between female officers and enlisted men. Immediate commanders may make exceptions to this policy in cases of relatives or fiancées/fiancés, in which instance, specific letters of authorization shall be issued to, and carried by the personnel concerned.

Extracts of 2d BD Instructions #35-3, dated 15 October 1943, are quoted for the information and compliance of all concerned:

"Fraternization between officers of this command and enlisted members of the Women's Army Corps will result in severe disciplinary action against both parties concerned."

"Women's Army Corps officers are entitled to the same military courtesies as other officers in the service of the United States."

3. SECURITY: Do not discuss with friends, strangers, or in public, nor include in letters, matters of possible military information. Under no circumstances will you divulge information regarding destination, number of personnel, type of transport, names or number of vessels, times of voyages, ports or airports of embarkation and debarkation, or names of military units involved in any convoy, or type of convoy or of any information (no matter how "insignificant" you may believe it to be) that might be of value to the enemy.
