1. AEF PROGRAM: The following AWK C-371-Y, 2d ID, dated 7 September 1944, is quoted for the information of all concerned:

"Effective Monday, 4 Sept, Allied Expeditionary Forces Program is broadcast on 154 meters and 563 kilocycles instead of previous wave length."

Jewish personnel will be transported from this station to the place of services and return. Trucks will leave the Post Exchange area 45 minutes before the time of beginning of each service. Jewish personnel wishing to attend these services will obtain a pass marked "Jewish Religious Services" from the Station Chaplain's Office during the 24-hour period preceding the Holy Day concerned.

Personnel attending the Day of Atonement service on 27 September will take along complete mess kits, including cups, in order to partake of the breakfast to be furnished at the end of the all day Fast of Atonement.


