We honor their service by conserving their records and stories, promoting historical research, and hosting educational and social programs." The 93<sup>rd</sup> BG Association is "dedicated to preserving the legacy of the men and woman who served in the 93<sup>rd</sup> Bombardment Group, 8<sup>th</sup> Air Force during World War II and to perpetuate the friendships and memories of service in the 93<sup>rd</sup>."
